

Priorities for 2009	
Broomfield Event Center	Sign agreement with and facilitate successful transition to a new operator.
Budget Review and Finances	Review regularly and adjust as necessary.
Small Business Retention / Attraction	Work with Broomfield Economic Development Corp. to increase small businesses in Broomfield, work with existing businesses to stay in Broomfield.
Comprehensive Water Use Plan	Overall water use plan including: Broomfield Reservoir, Chimney Hollow, stormwater fee, water conservation, report on water quality implications of beetle kill in mountains.
Transportation Projects	Comprehensive transportation plan for U.S. 36 EIS, RTD, North I-25 EIS, Jefferson Parkway, West 144 <sup>th</sup> Avenue, SH 7 – keep policy document of Broomfield’s positions on on-going and next steps on projects.
On-Going Priorities	
Wadsworth Interchange	Complete Wadsworth Interchange.
Unique Retail in Broomfield	Bring unique retailers to Broomfield in locations throughout the community that can become regional destinations.
Enhance “Green Broomfield” Efforts	National Civic League/UCD effort – Recycling – broad array of related projects – sustainable purchasing practices.
Healthy Broomfield	Create and promote Healthy Broomfield, Encourage actions, programs and activities that support Healthy Broomfield.
Internal Traffic Flow Improvements	Implement and monitor traffic flow improvements.
Manufacturing Jobs	Pursue manufacturing and industrial with other employment opportunities.
Lessen Local Government Burdens on Local Businesses	Examine ordinances and regulations that burden local businesses (e.g. sign code, business personal property tax). Consider partial exemption for business personal property tax.
Preservation of Property Values – Quality of Neighborhoods	Adopt Westlake Sub-Area Plan, consider rental ordinance, conduct election for property maintenance ordinance.
