Staff Report

2010 Budget- According to the approved budget, the Public Art Committee has \$43,993 available to spend. The final payment to Airworks Studio is in addition to this amount.

Metzger Farm Update-The Metzger Farm master plan was presented to City Council at the Tuesday March 9 meeting. The plan does include Public Art if funding can be obtained from both Broomfield and Westminster.

Airworks Mobile-Airworks would prefer to install the mobile when the building is closed. Installation is scheduled for April 9 and 10. The artists are available to attend a dedication reception on April 13 or 16. The committee discussed the date for the dedication and decided Friday April 16 from 4-6 pm would work best. Staff will work with the artists and arrange to use the lobby of the City and County building. The committee asked that past PAC members, past members of City Council as well as City staff be sent invitations. The public will also be invited.

Arts Advocacy Day-Karen and Dolly attended Arts Advocacy Day held on February 26 in Denver. Telluride and Creed were awarded the Governor's Arts Award.

UNFINISHED BUSINESS

1STBANK Center Art for Awhile Wall Update

The 1STBANK Center opened on March 5. Cultural Affairs has heard many positive comments about the art display wall. Dianna Wilson has already sold a piece of her artwork. PAC will receive 10% commission from that sale.
