Art for Awhile is an exciting art on loan program created by the Broomfield Public Art Committee and approved by the Broomfield City Council in 2009. Participating artists are chosen by the Broomfield Public Art Committee to display their art and offer it for sale for a predetermined period of time. The program affords the artist increased public exposure as well as the opportunity to sell his/her work, with a small percentage of the sale retained by the Broomfield Public Art Committee to be used for the funding of the permanent collection.

Three sculptures will be selected for installation on concrete bases on the west side lawn of the Mamie Doud Eisenhower Public Library and Broomfield Auditorium, which is the cultural center of the city. The site, located at 3 Community Park Road, affords excellent visual exposure from Main Street and the library and auditorium. There are 400,000 annual visitors to the cultural complex.

The Broomfield Public Art Committee will provide reinforced concrete bases and plaques for each piece, listing artist, materials, price and contact information for purchase. The Broomfield Public Art Committee will retain a 10% commission of the purchase price.

The artist loans his/her work to the City and County of Broomfield for one year for a \$750 honorarium. The City and County of Broomfield will provide insurance for the works.

The artist agrees to transport and install his/her work by September 10, 2010 and to leave the work on display until August 31, 2011. De-installation will be coordinated by the Broomfield Cultural Affairs Department by September 5, 2011.

Each artist may enter up to three pieces of outdoor sculpture, with a minimum height of 4'. Fragile, vulnerable or inappropriate work will not be considered. Artists will be selected and notified by July 16, 2010.
