The City and County of Broomfield in close coordination with CDPHE is actively monitoring this outbreak. Broomfield HHS recommends that daycare operators focus on prevention and planning within their facilities. Communicate with parents as much as possible as updates are made available.

Health Department Recommendations:

- **Stay home from work/school if you are sick and experiencing flu-like symptoms**
 - **Fever AND any combination of headache, fatigue, dry cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, muscle aches, or stomach symptoms (nausea, vomiting, diarrhea)**
- **Wash your hands often, supplement with hand sanitizers**
- **Cough and sneeze into your elbow or a tissue**
