

EMPLOYEE USE OF CITY AND COUNTY RECREATION FACILITIES

All employees may use the City and County's recreation facilities (Broomfield Recreation/Senior Center located at 280 Lamar Street, Paul Derda Recreation Center located at 13201 Lowell Boulevard and Broomfield Bay Aquatic Center at 250 Lamar Street) free of charge. All you need to do is present a City and County I.D. or pay stub at the Recreation Center, and a staff member will issue you a recreation center I.D. for a one time fee of \$5.00. This I.D. entitles you (not your family) to use the swimming pools, skate park, gymnasium, and weight room free of charge. In addition, limited space may be available for employees in fitness classes where they can participate at no cost (Please note: These programs may be full, so call before dropping in.). For schedules of classes and specific times for the open gym, swimming, and weight room, call the Community Center at 303-469-5351 or the Paul Derda Recreation Center at 303-460-6900.

The batting cages are available to employees at the same cost as non-employees.
