

## eBooks for the Kindle

From your Kindle or home PC, go to the library's homepage at [www.broomfieldlibrary.org](http://www.broomfieldlibrary.org)


Click on **Downloadable Audiobooks, Ebooks, & Music** in the blue column on the left.

Click on "Advanced Search" at the top, right-hand side of the page.



For "Format," select "Kindle Book" from the drop-down menu. If you want to see only titles that are now available for checkout, check the box next to "Only show titles with copies available." Or, you can also search by Title, Author, etc. Click "Submit."

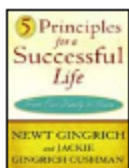

Download by clicking on "Get for Kindle." This opens the Amazon.com website. You may be required to sign in with your Amazon.com account if you are not already logged in. (Log into your Amazon account to which your Kindle is registered. To register a Kindle, select "Manage Your Kindle," then "Manage Your Devices," then "Register a Kindle.")

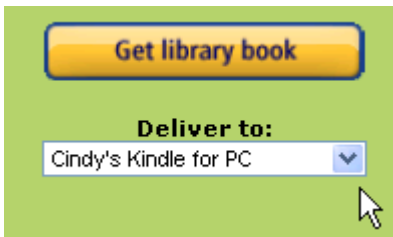

Select a Kindle device or Kindle reading app.



Click the “Get Library Book” button and sync your device or app to download the book, or choose to send it to your device via USB. (The newer Kindles sync automatically).

**NOTE:** *An active Wi-Fi connection is required for wireless delivery to a Kindle device.* If your Kindle is not Wi-Fi capable or you do not have an active Wi-Fi connection, read Amazon's instructions for transferring files via USB.

If your Kindle is Wi-Fi capable, your eBook will load directly to your Kindle and will appear in your booklist.

- To connect to your Wi-Fi network, press the “Menu” button, then select “Settings” to choose from the available Wi-Fi networks.
- Press the “Menu” button again to “Turn Wireless On.”

## Due Dates and Check-In When You Are Done

Your eBook is “due” either 7 or 14 days after you checked it out, depending on which option you chose at Check-Out. At the time of your due date, Amazon will send you a notification and the eBook will simply no longer be readable. There is nothing you have to do.

However, if you finish sooner than the due date, you can check-in the item early to be eligible to check out another eBook (remember, 4 eBooks max).

Here's how:

Log into your Amazon account.

Click on “Your Digital Items” near the top of the page. Then click on “Manage Your Kindle.” If you are not already logged in on your Amazon account, go ahead and do so.



Find the loaned title on your list of items.

Locate the “Actions” pull-down menu at the end of the line:

Choose “Return this book” from the menu. A Return Loan Confirmation box will pop up asking whether or not you really want to return the book to the library.

After you return the eBook, it will still show in Your Kindle Library list. To remove it from the list, selection Actions again, and from the drop-down menu select “Delete from library.”

Amazon offers Whispersync technology to preserve your notes and furthest page read if you want to check out the same title again later or purchase the eBook from the Kindle store. To retain such notes, make sure your **Settings > Annotations Backup** is turned “on.” If you do not want to retain that information, you can turn it “off.”
