



Reading Terrace Policy

Purpose:

As part of its community outreach service and for the enjoyment of the Broomfield community, the MDE Public Library provides an outdoor reading terrace for public use during library daylight hours.

Who may use the reading terrace?

- The reading terrace is available to the residents of the City and County of Broomfield and the general public.
- Children under the age of 12 must be supervised by an adult.

When will the reading terrace be available for use?

- The temperature must be above 60 degrees.
- The weather must be nice, and the light must be adequate for reading.

What are the conditions for use?

- The noise level must be consistent with the library atmosphere. Radios, stereos, and other music devices should be used with headphones.
- Covered drinks and food are permissible. However, food is not allowed inside the library.
- Smoking is not allowed.
- Standing on the furniture is not allowed.
- Library materials must be returned inside the library due to the uncertainty of the weather.
- The Library and the City and County of Broomfield are not liable for any loss of possessions.
- The Library and the City and County of Broomfield reserve the right to refuse use of the reading terrace at any time.
