#### Teen Advisory Board (TAB) Meetings

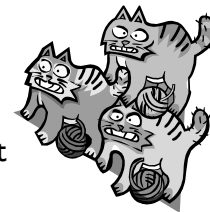

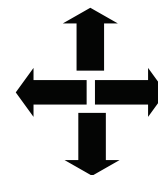
### September

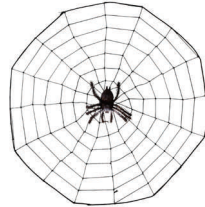

#### October Reading Program

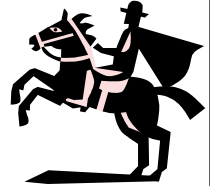
