Teen Advisory Board (TAB) Meetings

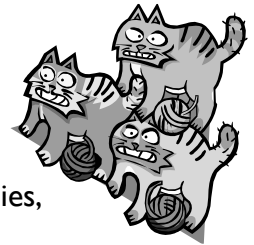

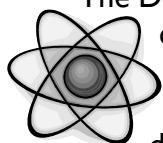

Energy at Play

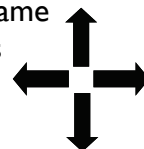
