

**BROOMFIELD RECREATION
ADULT INDOOR VOLLEYBALL LEAGUE RULES**

Current United States Volleyball rules will be used for and in conjunction with the following:

1. TEAM ROSTERS

A. A player's name must appear on a team's roster before he/she can play. Rosters will be frozen after the first round of league play. All players added after that date are subject to the approval of the league supervisor. Team rosters are unlimited, however awards will be limited. **In order to participate in a league tournament, a player must not only be on the roster, but also have played in at least one league game.**

2. PLAYER ELIGIBILITY

All players must be at least 16 years of age as of the current year or have a signed parent waiver.

3. GAME REGULATIONS

A. **Teams will play three games in a match with all three counting towards league standings. The first 2 will be rally scoring to 21, let serves. The third game will be to 15. Team must win by 2 with a 25 point cap. (17 if the game is to 15)**

B. Each team is allowed only one time-out per game.

C. The substitution rule for this league will be unlimited; however, each person must sub in between the same two people. Line calls will be on the honor system. 6 person B leagues may use the center back rotation. Must notify referee prior to game.

D. Six Person Leagues: Teams may start and finish the game with four players. For coed, a team may never have more than 3 males (2 males if playing with 4 players) on the court at any time. When playing with four or five, the serving position for the fifth and/or sixth player will be a side out. The Ghost only counts for the serve; it does not count for court position. Any player (male or female) that comes up from the back row may block **only**.

Four Person Leagues: Teams may play with no more than two men on the court at any time. Any combination of men and women is allowed as long as there is at least one from each gender on the court and a minimum of 2 players.

E. ***Game time is forfeit time.*** If a team is not ready to play at the scheduled game time, the first game will be forfeited and the team has 15 minutes before the next scheduled game is forfeited. Then they have 15 minutes before the final game is forfeited. Any team that forfeits two matches during the season may be dropped from the league with no refund.

F. All players must abide by all regulations and the Code of Conduct of the Broomfield Recreation Adult Volleyball League. Copies of these regulations are available upon request at the Broomfield Recreation Sports and Athletic Office.

G. Special Boundaries: In Aspen Creek Large Gym the center divider and the basketball goals are out of play.

H. Player Conduct: Any player that is issued a red card will be removed for the remainder of the match. If the same player is issued a second red card, they will be removed for the remainder of the match as well as the next match. If a third red card is issued, that player will be suspended from the league for one year.

Protest on player eligibility must be made before the last point of the first game. At time of protest a \$20 **CASH** fee must be paid to the gym supervisor. Player(s) in question will have five minutes to produce a picture I.D. If no proof of picture I.D. is available, the player(s) is ineligible to continue participation in that game/match. If no proof of I.D., the game the player was participating in is a forfeit. If the protest is upheld the \$20 fee will be returned.

4. 4 ON 4 RULES

A. USAV Doubles Rules will apply for all games.

1. Players may go under the net without a fault as long as there is no interference with other players.
2. No opened hand dinking is allowed
3. Serving order must alternate
4. There are no position faults.
5. If the ball is hit more than once (coed) the ball must be played by a woman before it goes over the net.
6. One toss per serve (if the ball drops to the ground or is caught it is a sideout).

5. TIE BREAKING PROCEDURES:

If two teams tie in the overall league record, the tie will be broken by head to head competition, and second on the point spread. If still tied, then comparison of the point spread based on total games played. If still tied, then flip of a coin.

ANY TEAM FORFEITING A GAME WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE DROPPED FROM THE TIE.

Please note:

If you bring children to your match, please make sure they remain in the gym, seated, and off of the bleachers.
