



Dear Coach,

Again this year we are going to have for those teams interested in participating, the **“Adopt a Team”** Program. This is how it works. Teams interested in participating would be “adopted” by one of our own girl’s youth recreational softball teams. (We have about 30 teams playing recreational softball in three age divisions).
