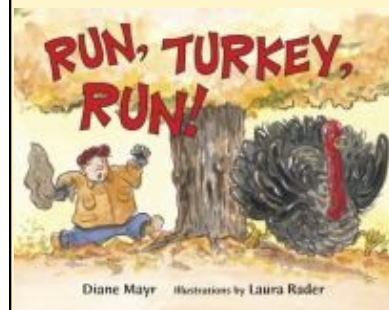


Discovery Playtime this month:

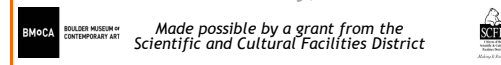


Art Stop On the Go
