


GET ACTIVE AT A RECREATION CENTER

BIKE TO BOULDER



PLAY IN A PARK

Broomfield boasts 700 acres of developed parks. Find the perfect park for your next outdoor get together. Visit some of our favorites:

Northmoor - A nice park with many amenities: tennis, basketball, soccer, baseball and a playground
Anthem Community Park - This park has an outstanding view of the Front Range
Lac Amora - A scenic park, home to Josh's pond and popular trails
East Park - A very beautiful park with mature cottonwoods
Broomfield Community Park - A hub of the community that houses City and County Buildings, ballfields, tennis courts and a skatepark

TRY A TRAIL

A vast, 281-mile trail system leads walkers, runners and cyclists around Broomfield and its parks and open space, which is currently 34.1% of Broomfield's land. Try one of these popular trails:

The Lake Link Trail - Eleven uninterrupted miles across Broomfield, east-west, linking a number of scenic water bodies
The Broomfield Trail - When complete, it will connect Broomfield north-south
The Southeast Community Loop Trail - Passes through the Civic Center area
The Rock Creek Trail - Spans from Superior to Erie along Broomfield's western border
