2nd Half Payment by **June 15**

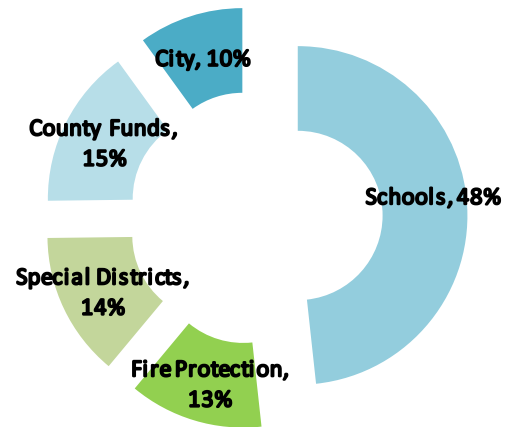

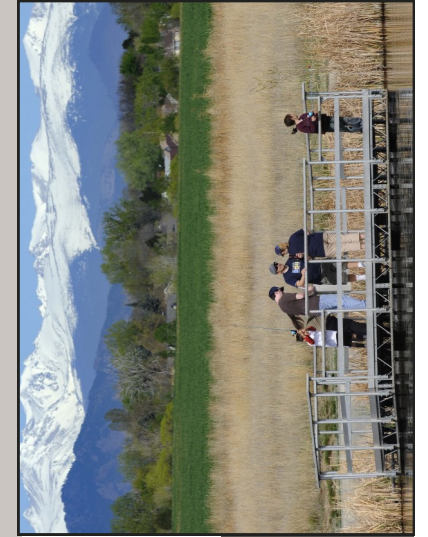
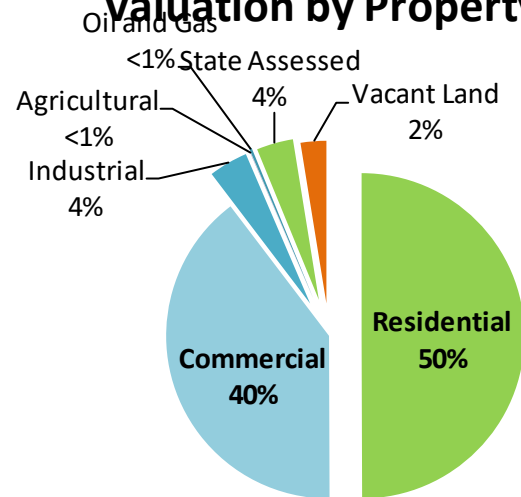
