'LOCK BOX' PROGRAM TO HELP SENIORS IN TIMES OF NEED

The 'LOCK BOX' program provides a combination lockbox to put a house key inside of and secure to your home. This doesn't have to be to the front door, it can be a side or back door, but you must note the location on your registration. This is the same type of system that realtors use when selling homes. The



combination to the lock is kept on file at the Police Department, and is easily accessible by dispatch in case of an emergency. If you are ever in a situation where you need the police or medical personnel to come into your home and you are unable to open the door, the police or paramedics will access the combination through dispatch. This will save valuable time and could save your life.

Eligibility requirements, participants must:

Live alone; have medical concerns; have no computer access; be over 65 years old
