A lighting system will inform viewers of the status of the fireworks show. Weather permitting, green means the show is a "go." Yellow indicates it is in a holding pattern, and red indicates the firework show is postponed to July 5 at approximately 9:30 p.m.



Leave all fireworks and charcoal grills at home. Residents are reminded that weather conditions always play a role in this annual event. If fire and police officials determine that continuing the fireworks display impacts the safety of individuals and property in the area, the fireworks could be delayed (until no later than 10 p.m.) or stopped. Should cancellation occur, announcements over the public address system in the stage area, updates on Broomfield's Facebook & Twitter feeds, and staff contact will be used to notify viewers of the status of the display.
