



Code of Conduct City & County of Broomfield Recreation Facilities

Any person in violation of the policies listed below for City and County of Broomfield Recreation Centers, which include the Paul Derda Recreation Center, the Broomfield Community Center, the Bay Aquatic Park, the Skate Park and the Batting Cages (“Facilities”), including all associated outdoor areas and children’s play areas in the Facilities, may be suspended from the property for a period of time determined by the Director of Recreation Services:

1. No smoking, or use of drugs or alcohol is allowed in the Facilities. The Facilities are smoke, tobacco, alcohol and drug free areas.
2. Food and beverage consumption in the Facilities is limited to lobby and lounge areas only. Water bottles are permitted in all areas of the Facilities, except where prohibited by individual room policies.
3. Profanity, verbal or physical fighting, roughhousing, and vandalism are strictly prohibited in the Facilities.
4. No violations of criminal or civil laws are allowed in the Facilities.
5. Use of the Facilities without proper payment of admission fees is strictly prohibited.
6. Loitering, where it is determined by management to be in conflict with the enjoyment of the Facilities by other patrons, is prohibited.
7. Patrons determined to be routinely inconsiderate of other patrons, staff, property and/or equipment will be suspended.
8. Shirts and shoes are required in all areas of the Facilities except for locker rooms, pools and pool adjacent areas.
9. Patrons 6 years of age or less must be accompanied by a paying adult (18 years of age or older). We recommend patrons age 8 or less, are accompanied by a parent, older sibling or other responsible party as designated by the parent.
10. All users of the Facilities shall know and comply with all other policies in the Facilities available on the City’s website.
11. **There is a zero tolerance policy for violations of this Code of Conduct.**
