



Residential Rebate Application

Follow these four steps to earn your rebate:

1. Verify that you qualify for Broomfield Water Conservation Rebates. See page 2 for complete eligibility rules and instructions.
2. Purchase a qualifying WaterSense model (see page 2 for details). Purchaser must be the one who applies for the rebate.
3. Attach a valid receipt (legible copies are acceptable-see page 2 for details), which must include the date, brand and model number to the application. Please include a photocopy of the cover of the owner's manual or packaging to verify WaterSense Certification, brand, make, and model number if it is not clearly indicated on the receipt. Keep a complete copy for your records.

4. Submit a completed application, a legible copy of your identification, and entire sales receipt to the City and County of Broomfield within 90 days of purchase date. NO EXCEPTIONS.

Failure to cash a rebate check within 90 days of issuance shall void the rebate and shall relieve Broomfield of any obligation or liability to pay the rebate. Rebates are awarded on a first come, first served basis dependent on available funds.

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Residential Rebate Application (page 2)

- **Rebates are awarded to Broomfield water customers on a first come, first served basis dependent on available funds. Provide your utility billing account number in the box on Page 1.**
- New construction does not qualify.
- The rebate applicant must be the purchaser of the fixture.
- All application forms must be accompanied by a **valid sales receipt**. A valid receipt includes date purchased, manufacturer name/make, model number and the price for each item. The valid receipt must indicate the item is paid-in-full. Legible copies of signed original receipts are acceptable—duplicate receipts without barcodes are not accepted.
- Online purchases must show the purchaser name, installation address, date purchased, manufacturer, make, and model of the fixture or device. Online purchase receipt must show a “paid” status.
- A photocopy of the cover of the owner’s manual or packaging is helpful to verify brand make and model number if it is not printed on the receipt. Keep a complete copy for your records.
- If you live in an apartment, condominium, or mobile home complex, please contact the management office and obtain your water billing account number. **Processing of applications without account numbers may be delayed. Application forms submitted without complete information or a valid receipt will not be processed.**
- Eligibility for rebates is limited to once every 10 years for the same item at the same property.
 - 3 toilets
 - 1 weather-based smart controller with on-site rain/freeze sensor (purchased separately)
 - 1 rebate for rotary nozzles

EXAMPLE: A customer who received the maximum toilet rebate in 2017 is not eligible to receive another toilet rebate until 2027.
- Send rebate applications to the City and County of Broomfield for processing.
- All rebate applications must be submitted within 90 days of the purchase date. No exceptions.
- Only new fixtures or appliances qualify. Toilets that are previously used, received from warranty or insurance claims, exchanged, or won as a prize do not qualify for this rebate.
- Broomfield may request access to customers’ properties in order to verify installation of devices eligible for rebates.
- Failure to cash a rebate check within 90 days of issuance shall void the rebate and shall relieve Broomfield of any obligation to pay the rebate.
- Keep a copy of the entire application and receipt for your personal records.

WaterSense Certified High-Efficiency Toilets (\$75 rebate, limit three per residence)

- Only WaterSense-labeled toilets that use **1.28 gallons per flush or less** and are listed at www.epa.gov/WaterSense/product_search.html are eligible.
- Limit three toilet rebates per residence.
- Low-flow toilets (1.6 gallons per flush) do NOT qualify for rebate.

Rotary nozzles (\$2 rebate, minimum purchase is 10)

- Eligible models include Hunter MP, Rain Bird, and Toro Precision rotary nozzles.
- Visit www.BroomfieldRebates.com for qualifying model list.
- One-time rebate per property.

WaterSense Certified Weather-Based Smart Controllers with on-site rain/freeze sensor (purchased separately) (purchase price up to \$100 rebate)

- Limit one weather-based smart controller rebate per residence.
- Requires on-site rain/freeze sensor and weather-based technology. Must have both to qualify; may need to be purchased separately; qualifying model list applies for controller only.
- Prices vary depending on the model, brand, and vendor.
- Equipment cost and labor must be separated on receipt.
